



Environmental Policy Statement

PROTEK (UK) Ltd is a professionally and environmentally conscious organization, acknowledging the impact that our operations may potentially have on the environment. **PROTEK UK** is to minimize any impact on the environment by:

- Preventing pollution, reducing waste and ensuring, wherever practicable, that measures are implemented to protect and preserve natural habitats, flora and fauna
- Considering the effects that our operations may have on the local community
- Taking action to eliminate or reduce, as far as practicable, any potentially adverse environmental impacts
- Promoting environmental awareness amongst our suppliers, contractors and partners by implementation of operational procedures
- Seeking to work in partnership with the community by behaving in a considerate and socially responsible manner
- Ensuring effective and expedient incident control, investigation and reporting
- Recycling of scrap metals through a company on the approved supplier list

The company environmental objectives are:

1. The company is to achieve a high standard of environmental compliance on site.
2. Reduction in the use of energy in the Fenton House office.
3. The Company to have zero environmental incidents.

Managerial and supervisory staff has responsibility for the implementation of the policy and must ensure that environmental issues are given adequate consideration in the planning and day-to-day supervision of all work.

All employees will be provided with the necessary resources, equipment, information, instruction and training to fulfill the requirements of this policy.
